**We are pleased that you will be participating in our 125<sup>th</sup> Labor Day Parade.**

Please arrive between 6:00am and 8:00am; this should assure you get in the Parade lineup. The Parade will start at 9:00am at Main Street and Clark Street in Princeton, Indiana.

There are several side streets we use to "store" our entries. Please look at our staging map as to where you are to stage your unit.

Only vehicles that are in the Parade are allowed along the Parade route. There is absolutely no parking allowed along the staging areas. Parking is available at the fairgrounds where you may park and then get a ride on one of the 4 shuttle buses running to and from the start of the Parade.

**Equestrian Units:** Pooper-scooper units are required for all equestrian units. You are to be as creative as you wish clowns etc.

**All Units:** As our Parade is so large (over 2 hours long) **we cannot allow the stopping of the Parade to perform** except in front of the reviewing stand. The local police have a concern with stopping traffic for 2 hours and we must try and help out in any way we can.

We also suggest that you might have some kind of music for your float. This makes an interesting Parade rather than a boring one for the crowd as well as the marchers.

Every effort is being made to make the Parade an enjoyable event for you. We need your help in making sure we don't have large gaps in the Parade and that we keep the Parade moving.
